



# Guitarist Knight to play at Townsend

Appalachian and delta blues guitarist Keith Knight will perform at the Townsend Center for the Performing Arts on Saturday, Jan. 21, at 7:30 p.m.

Knight is a solo fingerstyle guitarist who has been performing across the U.S. since 1993. With his acoustic guitars, dobro, and mandolin, Knight breathes new life into the traditional genres of Appalachian, ragtime and delta blues. His influences span from Blind Blake and Leadbelly to Leo

Kottke and Ry Cooder. Knight has shared the stage with national acts such as the Smothers Brothers, Scott Ainslie and the Freight Hoppers.

His high-energy finger picking and sophisticated melodic compositions bridge the gap of music listeners.

Knight has two solo CDs, "Hammer Thru the Silence" and "Tear It Up."
